

THE ROSENSTIEL COAT OF ARMS HEREBY ILLUSTRATED IS OFFICIALLY DOCUMENTED IN RIETSTAP ARMORIAL GENERAL. THE ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION OF THE ARMS (SHIELD) IS AS FOLLOWS:

"PARTI: AU 1 D'ARG. A UNE TIGE DE ROSIER DE SIN., FEUILLEE DU MEME, FLEURIE D'UNE ROSE DE GU. ET DE DEUX BOUTONS DU MEME; AU 2 DE GU. A UN SENESTROCHERE, ARM. D'ARG., TENANT UNE EPEE DU MEME, GARNIE D'OR."

WHEN TRANSLATED THE BLAZON ALSO DESCRIBES THE ORIGINAL COLORS OF THE ROSENSTIEL ARMS AS:

"DIVIDED VERTICALLY: 1) SILVER, A GREEN STEM OF A ROSE TREE BRANCH, LEAVED GREEN, FLOWERED WITH A RED ROSE AND TWO GOLD BUDS; 2) RED, A SILVER ARMOURED LEFT ARM POINTING LEFT, HOLDING A SILVER SWORD, GARNISHED GOLD."

1. HENRY LUDWICK<sup>1</sup> ROSENSTIEL was born February 16, 1817 in Gundersleben Schwarzburg Soudershousen, Germany, and died December 23, 1886 in Falmouth, Kentucky. He married MARY FRIEDRIKA SCHARBOCKEL.

#### Notes

Henry came to America when his son, Samuel was 8yrs old(ca. 1847); He entered at New York City then came to Cincinnati where he followed his trade(builder). Henry Fabra's father and wife gland bought 500 acres in Pendleton County, Falmouth, KY. There were several Germans who had located in that vicinity and they wanted Henry to move there and build a Luthern church which he did.

Henry built the Falmouth Church in 1871(it's still standing) Also built The Grebt Hotel Eckert Building, Grange Store, Henry Fabra's Residence and serveral others.

He moved to a 45acre of land bought from Mr. Beutle-to which other land was added to make a farm of 200 acres. Henry and his wife lived there for the remainder of their days.

He died at 1:00am at the age of 69yrs,9 mos, 7days.
